

Post-doctoral Position in Molecular Biology of B lymphocytes

A post-doctoral position is available in the “Genetic instability and transcriptional regulation” team headed by Dr Ahmed Amine Khamlichi, at the Institute of Pharmacology and Structural Biology, Toulouse, France (www.ipbs.fr). The position is funded by the ANR and is open for two years (with possible extension for a third year) starting January 2017.

The candidate will study the epigenetic mechanisms and regulatory elements that control class switch recombination at the immunoglobulin heavy chain locus by using available mutant mouse lines.

The candidate is expected to be highly motivated and to have a strong background in epigenetics and transcriptional regulation in complex loci. Although not absolutely required, some knowledge of B cell biology will be appreciated.

The net salaries comply with the salary scale of the French public service and depend on qualifications and experience (24,000 to 28,000 €/year).
